Our programs can enhance leadership skills, improve health and wellness, and help individuals/families become more economically self-sufficient.




### OTHER CASE MANAGEMENT

225 service encounters included support with basic case management such as telephonic translation, Khmer language support, review of correspondence, drafting letters to various systems, and bill pay.



### OTHER FOOD BENEFITS

207 service encounters included support with linkages to food support (outside of SNAP), teaching nutrition and healthy food options, collaborating with The Hep B Foundation to providing screenings, and gardening.



KITHS provides face to face encounters, telephonic support, in-office assistance, interpretation/language access needs, and many more.

KITHS hope to break the cycle of generational poverty among immigrants and refugees (especially among Cambodian immigrants and refugees) by supporting their healing and promoting economic development.


CLIENTS SERVED - FEMALE
